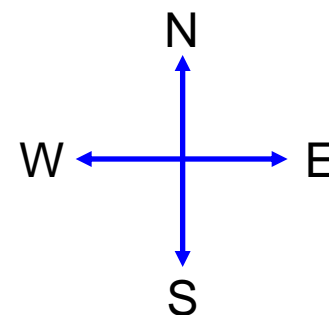
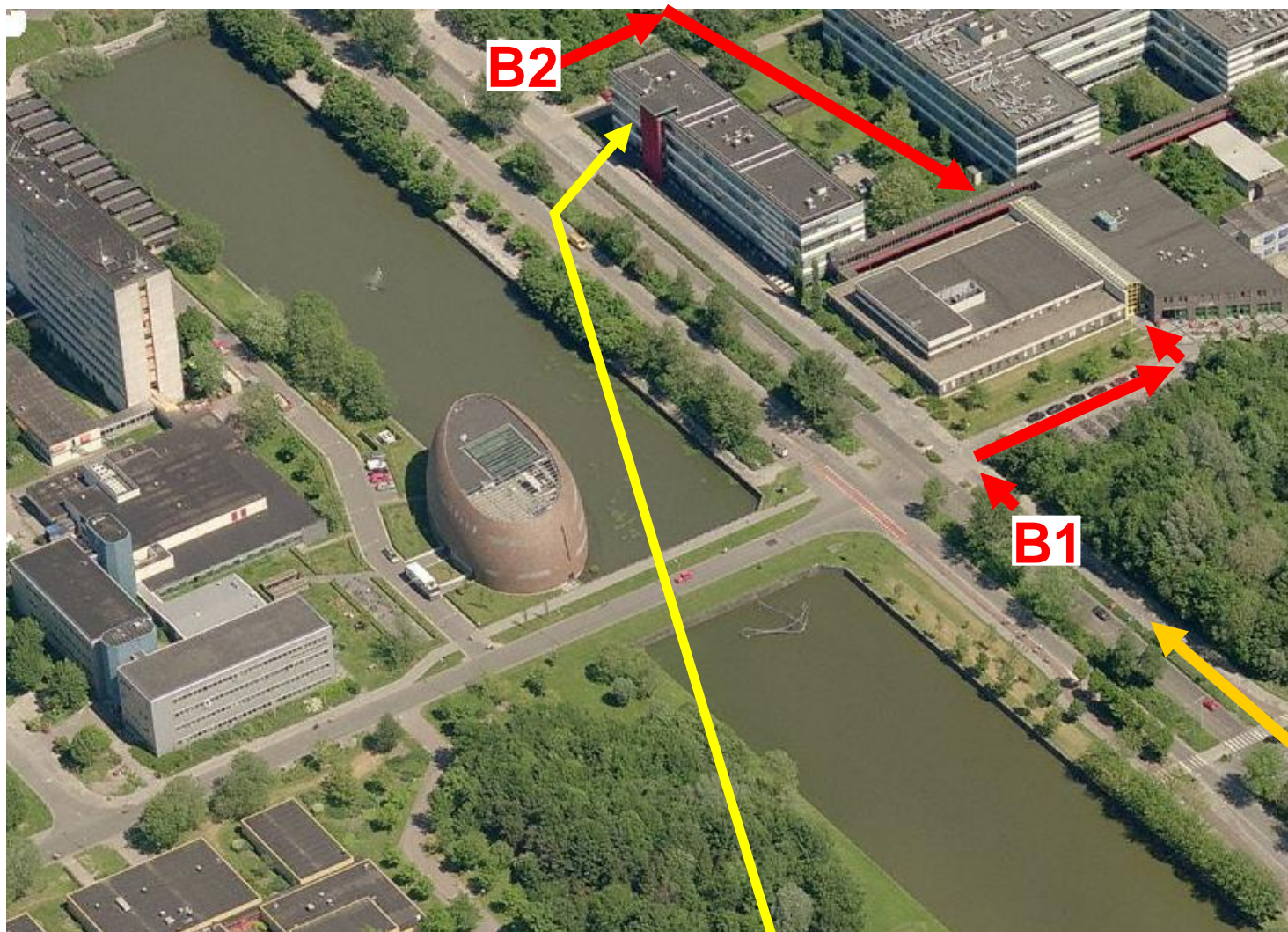


When using bus line 15 or 11, get off at “B1” (bus stop “Crematoriumlaan”) or “B2” (bus stop “Nijenborgh”). Follow the red arrows in this picture to one of the two main entrances of Physics and Chemistry (street address and building name is “Nijenborgh 4, Groningen”). Use the **yellow** doors in the far left corner when coming from the bus stop at “B2”.



Bus and taxi coming from the train station and city center arrive at the Zernike Complex from this direction.

The labs of Caspar van der Wal, Tamalika Banerjee and Bart van Wees are located at this point in this building. Inside the buildings for Physics and Chemistry, the place is known as “Gebouw/Building 13”, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, rooms 140 (Caspar), 230 (Bart), and 226 (Tamalika).
